



Hazwoper 40 Hour

The HAZWOPER standard applies to five (5) distinct groups of employers and their employees. This includes any employees who are exposed or potentially exposed to hazardous substances—including hazardous waste—and who are engaged in one of the following operations as specified by 1910.120(a)(1)(i-v) and 1926.65(a)(1)(i-v)

Hazwoper 40 hour Topics Covered

- Government-required clean-up operations
- Corrective actions covered by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (RCRA)
- Voluntary clean-up operations at uncontrolled hazardous waste sites
- Treatment, storage and disposal facility (TS&D) operations
- Emergency response operations
